

BC Original Minds Association Scholarship Fund 2024

Terms of Reference for Scholarship Eligibility

Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must be in Grade 12 and eligible to graduate (within the year of application) from any secondary school in BC.
- 2. Applicant must have a satisfactory Grade Point Average.
- 3. Applicant must have the intention to pursue secondary education and/or training: proof of registration (full-time) in a post-secondary institution or training school (a "qualified done under the Canadian Income Tax Act") will be required before any money is disbursed to the student's credit at the school.
- 4. Applicants must be (or have been) registered as a team member for a Destination Imagination Challenge and have competed in at least one tournament.
- 5. Applicants must include a letter from their team manager.
- 6. Individual achievement(s) will be taken into consideration including, but not limited to arts, athletics, academics, community service.
- 7. The successful applicant must provide proof of full-time registration within the second year after the awarding of the scholarship.

Nomination Process:

The BC Original Minds Association will appoint a Scholarship Selection Committee. All information will be held in confidence by the committee. The scholarship winners will be contacted individually and announced on our website.
