



BC Original Minds Association Scholarship Fund 2024

Terms of Reference for Scholarship Eligibility

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be in Grade 12 and eligible to graduate (within the year of application) from any secondary school in BC.
2. Applicant must have a satisfactory Grade Point Average.
3. Applicant must have the intention to pursue secondary education and/or training: proof of registration (full-time) in a post-secondary institution or training school (a “qualified done under the Canadian Income Tax Act”) will be required before any money is disbursed to the student’s credit at the school.
4. Applicants must be (or have been) registered as a team member for a Destination Imagination Challenge and have competed in at least one tournament.
5. Applicants must include a letter from their team manager.
6. Individual achievement(s) will be taken into consideration including, but not limited to arts, athletics, academics, community service.
7. The successful applicant must provide proof of full-time registration within the second year after the awarding of the scholarship.

Nomination Process:

The BC Original Minds Association will appoint a Scholarship Selection Committee. All information will be held in confidence by the committee. The scholarship winners will be contacted individually and announced on our website.
